ALL STATIONS THE WEATHER FORECAST FOR (THURSDAY, October 8, 2020)... ORZ617

...Breezy to gusty winds and dry humidities east of the Cascades in this afternoon and evening....

.DISCUSSION... Breezy winds and dry humidities are expected for areas east of the Cascades this afternoon and evening. Humidities will trend higher today through Friday and significantly increase Saturday. A relatively strong cold front will move through the area Saturday bringing gusty winds to the coast, mountains and east of the Cascades. Chances for wetting rain will be highest from the Southern Oregon Cascades west, across western Siskiyou and across northern Klamath and northern Lake Counties. Additional chances for light showers are expected Saturday night and Sunday.

.Today...

- * Sky/weather..... Mostly cloudy until noon, then partly cloudy. Areas of smoke and fog until noon, then patchy smoke.
- * Max temperature.....65-75 valleys and 60-65 ridges.
- * Min humidity.....35-50 percent.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Valleys/lwr slopes...Light winds becoming west 5 to 6 mph in the afternoon.
- * Ridges/upr slopes....South winds 5 to 6 mph shifting to the west in the afternoon.
- * Haines index.....4 or (low).
- * LAL.....1.
- * Chc of wetting rain (.10 in)...0 percent.

.TONIGHT...

- * Sky/weather.....Partly cloudy. Haze and patchy smoke.
- * Min temperature.....Around 50 valleys and 40-45 ridges.
- * Max humidity.....90-95 percent valleys and 70-85 percent ridges.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Valleys/lwr slopes...West winds 5 to 6 mph in the evening becoming light.
- * Ridges/upr slopes....West winds 5 to 6 mph shifting to the south after midnight.
- * Haines index.....4 or (low).
- * LAL.....1.
- * Chc of wetting rain (.10 in)...0 percent.

.FRIDAY...

- * Sky/weather.....Partly cloudy early in the morning then clearing. Haze until noon.
- * Max temperature.....70-75 valleys and 60-65 ridges.
- * Min humidity.....40-50 percent.
- * 20-foot winds.....
- * Valleys/lwr slopes...Light winds becoming southwest 5 to 6 mph in the afternoon.
- * Ridges/upr slopes....South winds 5 to 6 mph shifting to the southwest 5 to 8 mph in the

afternoon.

- * Haines index.....2 or (very low).
