.DISCUSSION... ..GUSTY WINDS EAST AND WEST OF THE CASCADES TOMORROW...Gusty winds and low RH will bring critical fire weather conditions east of the Cascades and in northern California Saturday. West of the Cascades, breezy winds will also occur with higher RH's on Saturday. Temperatures will be on a cooling trend with the trough moving inland this weekend then start to trend up towards the start of next week. There is a very slight chance for thunderstorms on Wednesday.
